

Make a Time Machine

What You Need

Printout of page two, Scissors, Glue, Split pin

What to Do

1. Ask a grown up to help you cut out the time machine pieces on page two of this craft sheet
2. Ask your grown up to put your split pin through the red dots on clock hand first, then through the centre of your time machine. Fold the pin back behind your time machine
3. Glue your two large time machine pieces together, back to back so that the holes in the lid line up
4. Fold your time machine so that it has a lid
5. Use your imagination to power your time machine, turning the clock back and chanting the magic words...

“Turn the clocks back, turn the clocks back, turn the clocks back, all the way back!”
